- And in process ... Accountants

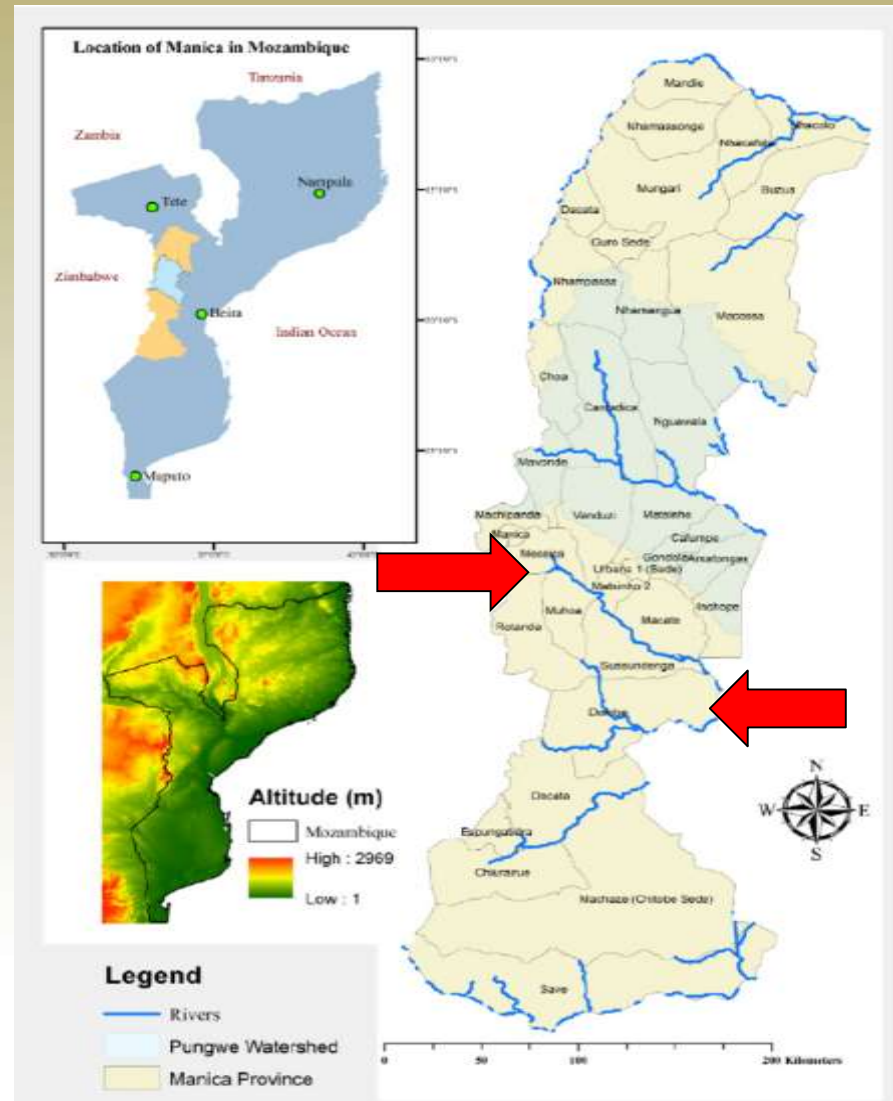

- **COMPUTER PROJECT:** Reviewing the position of the container that currently has the computers we sourced in London. Monitoring the situation with the Technical school in Vila Maninga.
- **LIBRARY PROJECT: VILANCULOS** Government drafted plans and we are in the process of raising funds for the project. →
- **BICYCLE PROJECT:** Providing each orphan with a bicycle to help with transport and school distances.
Budget UK£100 per bicycle x 15 = £1,500
